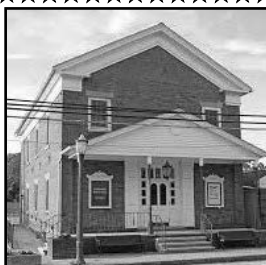

## New Headquarters & Museum Grand Opening

On January 27, 2024 our new Headquarters & Museum launched a soft grand opening for the community of Valley City & Liverpool Township in rural Medina County, Ohio. A brief history of our organization and who we are was shared with attendees as well as celebratory cake & punch. National President Madeline Rock was then bestowed the honor of the official ribbon cutting as guests were able to enter our new museum room for the first time. Located on the 2nd floor of this historic building, the new LGAR Museum promises something for everyone. Our most treasured item is of course our archives collection, and before too long our electronic database will be available for anyone to see if they had a relative as a member in the LGAR or learn who their Civil War ancestor is. Since the room is 4 times larger than our last museum space, much of the collection is now able to be shared with the public, to fully tell our story. One corner of the room will feature a rotating display on something Civil War related. At the moment this corner features another prestigious Civil War organization & collection. The meeting room area is set up with original G.A.R. stations and is ready to teach about our historic floor work traditions. There is a designated location in which to drop your donation items into our "Pets for Vets" box, or your baked goods or Christmas stockings for Miss Sawyer's "Kids with a



"Cause" nonprofit that sends boxes to our currently deployed military. Our supplies that we sell as an organization is featured in one display case, and those rare items such as printing dies, seals, photographs, charters & flags can be found throughout the room. The LGAR Headquarters & Museum will sponsor 2 upcoming fundraisers, an Irish Murder Mystery Dinner on March 16th, and a Mother's Day Tea with 1860's Fashion Show on May 12th. The Headquarters Committee will host a summer children's program for a few weeks, and will participate in the town's "Frog Jumping Contest" which is a fun, family event. The official Grand Opening for this new space will take place at the beginning of our National Convention to be held beginning August 8th, 2024.

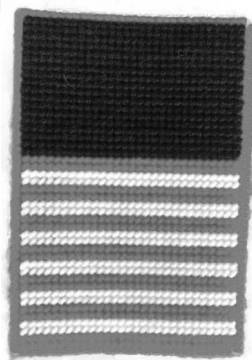

### Travels:

Since our last issue, I am excited to share a few important travels. At the end of September, I traveled to Ludington, Michigan with Marine Corps Veteran Brandon Ervin to drop off stockings, baked goods, and cards to Miss Sawyer Hendrickson of Miss Sawyer's Kids with a cause for her Christmas Stocking Project. This is a huge project and I am so thankful for everyone that has assisted and put in many hours to get everything moved and unpacked and put on display. We are so excited to share it with you all!

For Veteran's Day this past November, I started off with laying flowers at Western Reserve National Cemetery in a few different personal locations, including the G.A.R. Memorial. I then spent the evening at MAPS Air Museum for their Veterans Day Event. Their newest aircraft, the C-130H Hercules "Spirit of Mansfield" was dedicated and the 179th Airlift Wing/164th Airlift Squadron from the Ohio Mansfield-Lahm Air National Guard Base were honored. It was a great night surrounded by and appreciating our veterans!

Later in November, I traveled to Gettysburg, PA for Remembrance Day. I laid a wreath at the Albert Woolson Monument, hand delivered our donation to the American Battlefield Trust, participated in the parade where we received a wonderful voiceover on their livestream, and participated in multiple ceremonies/laid many flowers with members at the Irish Brigade Monument and 11th PA monument to remember dogs and other animals lost during the battle. On the 19<sup>th</sup>, the actual anniversary of Lincoln's Gettysburg Address, I attended the 160th Anniversary of Lincoln's Gettysburg Address. The keynote speaker was Susan Eisenhower, the Gettysburg Address was given by Emmy Nominated Actor Graham Sibley, words from Harold Holzer, words from the

## Remembrance and Dedication Day in Gettysburg

Various Civil War living history groups and organizations marched down Middle and Baltimore Streets in this year's 67th Annual Remembrance Day Parade. The LGAR was represented by Nat'l President Madeline Rock, Nat'l Treasurer Jan Stevenson, Nat'l Secretary/PNP Elizabeth Rock, Nat'l Historian/PNP Lynne Bury, and members from the Isaac Rice Circle in PA and Dept of PA Officers!



Nat'l President Madeline Rock laid a wreath at the Albert Woolson Memorial. This wreath laying ceremony commemorates the last living union soldier of the Civil War. Born in 1850, Woolson enlisted as a Drummer boy. He lived to be 106, passing in 1956.

Dedication Day refers to November 19, 1863, the day the Soldiers National Cemetery or now called Gettysburg National Cemetery was dedicated by Abraham Lincoln, as well as the day he gave the Gettysburg Address. The dedication day ceremony was held at the Majestic Theater at Gettysburg College. The speakers included Susan Eisenhower, Harold Holzer, the Superintendent of the Gettysburg National Military Park. The Gettysburg Address was given by Emmy Nominated Actor Graham Sibley. The ceremony concluded with a tribute performance to Marian Anderson was given by two-time Grammy winning opera singer J'Nai Bridges.

This year marked the 22nd anniversary of the Candle Luminary at the Gettysburg National Cemetery. Volunteers light the graves of the 3,512 Civil War soldiers' with luminaries. This event allows us to remember and honor these soldiers as their names are read throughout.

## Yearly Report Time

It's incredibly important for all members to participate in the yearly reporting time of our organization. All members are asked to report the total number of hours for the last year that pertain to our worthy categories. Your Circle may ask you to turn in those numbers to the respective Circle Officer, or to the Circle Secretary. In the case of Membership-at-Large, these members can turn in their activities to the MAL coordinator. Everyone most likely has done *something in the last year that could be counted. There are 5 basic categories:*

1. Community Service (Jr. Vice responsibility) which includes any and all community service based activities. Total up those hours that you have given to any service project in your region.
2. Chaplain Work (Chaplain responsibility), did you attend a memorial service for a departed member or organize a Circle moment of remembrance? We have lost many Circle Sisters this year, so hopefully you are paying tribute to them in some way.
3. Patriotic Work (Patriotic Instructor responsibility) if you have taught the pledge to our flag to anyone, flew your flag for holidays or year round, distributed flags in cemeteries etc. report the time it took to complete these projects.
4. Historical Work (Historian responsibility), did you participate in any historic events this past year or helped to maintain a historic property? We want to hear about it!
5. Genealogy & Membership Work (Registrar responsibility), did you assist with genealogy help in order to gain a new member? The time it took to complete this process should be recorded.

Why is this so important? This is the backbone of our organization. These hours get submitted to their respective National Officer from your Circle (or Department). Hours are then totaled for each category and reported at our National Convention. They are then published yearly in our National Proceedings, which goes off to Congress to maintain our Congressional Charter. We know you did something! Please share it.
